#### PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

#### **BOROUGH OF BEACH HAVEN QUESTION**

Shall the Borough of Beach Haven establish an annual levy at the rate of \$0.01 per \$100.00 of assessed value of real property located in the Borough and annually appropriate that revenue for any or all of the following purposes, or any combination thereof:

- a. acquisition of lands for recreation and conservation purposes;
   b. development of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes;
   c. maintenance of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes;
- d. historic preservation of historic properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas, or objects, and the acquisition of such properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas, or objects for historic preservation purposes; or e. payment of debt service on indebtedness issued or incurred by the Borough for any of the purposes set forth in paragraphs (a),
- (b), (c), or (d) herein above?

### INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

A "yes" vote on this question would allow the Borough of Beach Haven to establish a "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" to be funded annually through the collection of a dedicated open space tax in the amount of one cent per one hundred dollars of assessed value. This tax would be dedicated to the maintenance, improvement or acquisition of land for recreation and conservation purposes, and the acquisition and preservation of historic properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas, or objects, or for payment of debt service or indebtedness issued or incurred by the Borough for any of these purposes. Approval may also enhance the Borough's ability to qualify for NJ State Green Acres funds under the Planning Incentive Acquisition Program and enable the Borough to qualify for any future programs, presently not in existence, which might condition a municipality's eligibility to receive open space funds on the adoption of a tax levy and the creation of a "Municipal Open Space, Pecreation and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" Recreation, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund."

A "no" vote means that you do not support annually funding a "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" through the collection of a dedicated open space tax in the amount of one cent per one hundred dollars of assessed value.

# INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

- The Board Worker will hand you a ballot card and a voting authority; DO NOT FOLD THE BALLOT CARD. Take the card to the voting machine and insert with the cut side to the top right.
- A language selection appears on the screen, follow the prompts by touching the screen for English or Spanish.
- Choose "Start Voting", then make your selections by touching the candidate's name of your choice on the screen.
- If you need to view the ballot or any contest in a larger font, touch "TEXT SIZE" and then touch "LARGE TEXT" and then touch "RETURN TO BALLOT"
- To vote for a person whose name is not shown, touch the "WRITE IN" box in the "PERSONAL CHOICE" column and type in the candidate's name on the keyboard shown on the screen. Touch "ACCEPT"
- Review all selections on the ballot screen. To make a change, touch the contest (name of candidate) and make a selection.
- Touch "PRINT BALLOT". A pop-up window will be displayed giving you the options to either "PRINT" or "RETURN TO BALLOT".
- Touch "PRINT" if you want to continue casting your vote.
- The machine prints the ballot and displays it in the window to the right for you to review, giving you the option to either "CAST" or "QUIT".

  If you are satisfied with the ballot touch "CAST". The ballot cord is then deposited in a secure cord cartains. If you are satisfied with the ballot touch "CAST". If you choose "QUIT", the machine will return the ballot card to you and will direct you to seek the help of a poll worker.
