



Freeholder Director John P. Kelly opened the meeting at 4:00 PM and read the Statement of Compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act. The Clerk of the Board called the roll.

Director Kelly noted that at the last Board meeting a resident raised questions regarding County road improvements in Lakewood. The Director advised that a meeting has been scheduled for next Wednesday with Lakewood officials, Senator Singer, the County Administrator, Assistant County Administrator and the County Engineer John Ernst to discuss County roads that come out to Route 9. Director Kelly also advised that discussions will be held regarding the northern sections of the County. The County is looking to come up with a long term plan and discuss what the priorities are for the northern end of the County for the most effective use of our dollars. The Director stated that this process began years ago and we continue to move forward.

Freeholder Bartlett stated that this gentleman said that the County has not done anything in decades in Lakewood. The Freeholder advised that New Hampshire Avenue was upgraded to a four lane road and the County has been very proactive with many, many other roads in Lakewood. Director Kelly stated that Lakewood Township is growing faster than any other township in the County, in the past it was Toms River. The Director noted that it is difficult to keep up with roads when accelerated growth is occurring quickly in Lakewood Township. Director Kelly stated that the County is developing a Master Plan which will show all the improvement plans in this area with an estimated timeline for the anticipated projects. Freeholder Bartlett noted that the last time a study was done was for the bridge in downtown Toms River. The Freeholder stated that it was anticipated that the bridge would improve the problems in that area at the time but the improvements solved the problem and the traffic study proved it. Freeholder Kelly noted that the County has considered opening County Line Road to four lanes, however, this is not feasible and the County may be open to three lanes with a center turning lane.

Director Kelly stated that there is a need for an updated Master Plan for the northern towns to include Brick, Jackson, Lakewood and Toms River where the bulk of the traffic concerns are located. The Director advised that he will report back to this Board as the report moves along in the process. The Director advised that Senator Singer wants to be an advocate for this and will work with the County. Mr. Ernst noted that the County will be meeting with the four municipalities before we start the study. This will be a cooperative effort.

Mr. Ernst reviewed the items listed on the attached Engineering Department agenda. There were no questions or comments, and all items will be listed on the agenda for the December 21, 2016 Board meeting.

Freeholder Bartlett advised that he had four Natural Lands Trust Fund (NLTF) acquisitions to review with the Board today. The Freeholder noted that they all have been recommended for acquisition by the Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee.

Freeholder Bartlett noted that the first acquisition in located in Berkeley Township (13 acres) on Route 9. This parcel adjoins the Florence Allen Conservation Area which the County already owns and is maintained by the Parks Department. Berkeley Township will partner on this acquisition at a 50 percent cost share. The owner originally offered the property for \$1 million. Freeholder Bartlett advised that the negotiated price for this parcel is \$865,000, noting that the County's share will be \$432,500.

Freeholder Bartlett stated that a number of years ago land near the Garden State Parkway in Beachwood was purchased by the County from David Lipton and Beachwood Borough donated additional land in the area. The parcel recommended for acquisition today is a .18 acre parcel. No appraisal was done, but the negotiated price of \$500 is the assessed value of the property.

The next parcel is located in Manchester Township and is an 11.10 acre site located on Cherry Street and Route 539. Freeholder Bartlett noted the negotiated price is \$105,000 which is less than the appraised value. The Freeholder also noted that this parcel is adjoins property already in County ownership and near the Joint Base at Fort Dix.

Freeholder Bartlett advised that the fourth parcel is located on Pancoast Road in Barnegat and Ocean Townships and is 95 acres. The Freeholder stated that this is an old paper subdivision that is adjacent to the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Reservations. The property is also located adjacent to other Natural Lands Trust Fund properties. The Freeholder advised that the negotiated price is \$635,000 and noted that the Trust for Public Land is donating 10 percent of the purchase price. The County share will not exceed \$575,500.

Freeholder Bartlett noted that properties only come to the Board for review after they have been recommended by the NLTF Advisory Committee and municipalities have to approve of the acquisition. All four recommended parcels will be listed on the Board agenda of December 21, 2016 for acquisition.

Freeholder Vicari stated that Ocean County has the largest program in the State for meals on wheels. The Director introduced Jackie Rohan, Director of Senior Services to provide an update for the Board.

Ms. Rohan stated that the cost of the congregate meal contract is \$782,173 and weekday home delivered meals is \$1,819,517. Ms. Rohan noted that approximately 1,000 meals are delivered every day in Ocean County and there is no waiting list in Ocean County. Ms. Rohan advised that an added benefit of the home delivered meals is that someone drops the meal off and also checks on our seniors, noting that sometimes this is the only contact a senior receives. Ms. Rohan stated this has a tremendous value – the cost for a day in a non for profit hospital is \$2,500 a day and the cost for home delivered meal is \$2,200 for a year. Director Kelly stated that 94 percent of the home delivered meals are for moderate to high risk seniors. The Director noted that the County has nutrition sites available for seniors who are able to travel to for a meal. Director Kelly stated that this is a valuable program and this Board appreciates the work of the Department of Senior Services.

Ms. Vasil reviewed the Clerk of the Board's agenda for the Board meeting of December 21, 2016. There were no questions or comments.

Director Kelly asked the Board members for comments.

There were no comments.

Director Kelly asked the Administrator for comments during open session.
