WHEREAS, the voters of Ocean County authorized the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund to provide funds for the acquisition and preservation of natural lands, open spaces and farmland; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee was established by the Board of Chosen Freeholders to review nominations to the program and forward recommendations for acquisition to the Board of Chosen Freeholders; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee has received a nomination for the property identified as Block 19403, p/o Lots 2 & 30 in Jackson Township totaling approximately 25 acres located on Whitesville Road; and

WHEREAS, two professional appraisals have been completed to establish the fair market value of the property; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee has determined the property's attributes are consistent with the Ocean County Open Space Plan and Recreation Inventory; and

WHEREAS, a tentative agreement has been reached to acquire the property for an amount not to exceed \$1,200,000 of equivalent land value of the property; and

WHEREAS, this property has been identified as a high priority area for the Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst due to its location within the flight path and within close proximity to Accident Potential Zones; and

WHEREAS, this property is eligible for funds from the United States Department of Defense consistent with the agreement authorized by resolution dated August 15, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Board of Chosen Freeholders conducted a public hearing on the proposed acquisition on February 3, 2016 as required by PL 1997, c24.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS OF THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY as follows:

- 1. It accepts the recommendation of the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund Advisory Committee to participate in the acquisition of Block 19403, p/o Lots 2 & 30 in the Township of Jackson.
- 2. It authorizes the expenditure not to exceed \$1,200,000 in acquisition funds from the Ocean County Natural Lands Trust Fund, Account Number 225-155-0151.

OCEAN COUNTY BOARD OF CHOSEN FREEHOLDERS URGES THE BANNING OF THE SALE OF "PUPPY AND KITTEN MILL" DOGS AND CATS FROM PET SHOPS

WHEREAS, a significant number of puppies and kittens sold at pet shops come from large-scale, commercial breeding facilities where the health and welfare of the animals are not adequately provided for ("puppy mills" and "kitten mills," respectively). According to The Humane Society of the United States, it is estimated that 10,000 puppy mills produce more than 2,400,000 puppies a year in the United States and that most pet shop dogs and cats come from puppy mills and kitten mills; and

WHEREAS, the documented abuses endemic to puppy and kitten mills include over-breeding; inbreeding; minimal to non-existent veterinary care; lack of adequate and nutritious food, water and shelter; lack of socialization; lack of adequate space; and lack of adequate exercise; and

WHEREAS, the inhumane conditions in puppy and kitten mill facilities lead to health and behavioral issues in the animals bred in those facilities, which many consumers are unaware of when purchasing animals from pet shops due to both a lack of education on the issue and misleading tactics of pet shops in some cases. These health and behavioral issues, which may not present themselves until sometime after the purchase of the animals, can impose exorbitant financial and emotional costs on consumers; and

WHEREAS, according to the New Jersey Department of Health 2014 Animal Intake and Disposition Survey, due in large part to pet overpopulation, more than 20,000 dogs and cats are euthanized in New Jersey animal shelters annually. Restricting the retail sale of puppies and kittens to only those that are sourced from animal shelters and rescue organizations will likely reduce pet overpopulation and thus the burden on such agencies and financial costs on local taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, across the country, thousands of independent pet shops as well as large chains operate profitably with a business model focused on the sale of pet services and supplies and not on the sale of dogs and cats. Many of these shops collaborate with local animal shelters and rescue organizations to offer space and support for showcasing adoptable homeless pets on their premises, including cooperative efforts with our local Ocean County Animal Shelters; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Board of Chosen Freeholders does not want to affect a consumer's ability to obtain a dog or cat of his or her choice directly from a breed-specific rescue organization or a shelter, or from a responsible breeder within the State of New Jersey where the consumer can see directly the conditions in which the dogs or cats are bred, or can confer directly with a responsible breeder concerning those conditions, and would like to encourage responsible pet ownership; and

WHEREAS, the Ocean County Board of Chosen Freeholders believes it is in the best interests of all pet owners to help prevent inhumane breeding conditions, promote community awareness of animal welfare, and foster a more humane environment in the county.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ocean County Board of Chosen Freeholders applauds the enactment of Senate Bill No. 1870, the "Pet Purchase Protection Act. The Ocean County Department of Consumer Affairs is actively and aggressively enforcing the ban of the sale of dogs and cats that come from large scale commercial breeding facilities ("puppy mills" and "kitten mills).
