Student/FacultyRatio: - This is the number of students per faculty member. It is calculated by dividing the reported October school enrollment by the combined full-time equivalents (FTEs) of classroom teachers and educational support services personnel assigned to the school as of October of the school year.

PARCC: - Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers -the PARCC assesses how well students have learned grade-level material in English Languages Arts/Literacy (ELA/L) and Math. The tests include questions that measure students' fundamental skills and knowledge, and require them to think critically, solve problems and support or explain their answers. The PARCC reports students' overall scale scores that range from 650 to 850. To determine whether students have met academic expectations for their grade level/course in ELA/L and Math, students' overall scale scores are categorized into five Performance Levels. Students performing at levels 4 and 5 (met or exceeded expectations) have demonstrated readiness for the next grade level/course, and are on track for college and careers.

NJASK 4 & 8: - New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge - The statewide assessment system comprises state tests that are designed to measure student progress in the attainment of the Core Curriculum Content Standards. Under the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB)*, The state assesses science in grades four and eight. Based on their score in each section, students are identified as Partially Proficient, Proficient, and Advanced Proficient. The figures represent the total percentage of students who achieved Proficient or Advanced Proficient. The PARCC replaced the NJASK english and mathematics sections.

HSPA: - High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) -High schools show assessment results from the 11th grade spring 2010 administration of the High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) in language arts and math. The HSPA is the test that students must pass in order to graduate from high school. Retests are not included in these results.

SAT: - The Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) is a voluntary test administered by the College Board, usually for the purpose of college admission. Each portion is graded on a scale of 200 to 800 points. The average score for each school is greatly affected by the percentage of students taking the test. In general, the higher the participation, the lower the average score.
