The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$29,958,000 (consisting of \$14,085,000 for Lacey Township High School, \$3,725,000 for Lacey Township Middle School, \$2,148,000 for Creek Elementary School, \$2,150,000 for Forked River Elementary School, \$2,382,000 for Lanoka Harbor Elementary School, and \$5,468,000 for Mill Pond Elementary School). EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

At this election, the voters of the school district are being asked to consider Bond Proposal Questions No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3. As set forth above, Bond Proposal Question No. 2 will only go into effect if Bond Proposal Question No. 1 is also approved by the voters at this election, and Bond Proposal Question No. 3 will only go into effect if Bond Proposal Question No. 1 is also approved by the voters at this election.
