The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Sustainable Waste Management, Bureau of Solid Waste Planning and Licensing is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Ocean County Solid Waste Management Plan (Plan) dated November 13, 2024. This amendment to the Plan proposes inclusion of a Research, Development, and Demonstration (RD&D) project for EACR, Inc.'s Lakewood Township facility. The amendment also proposes inclusion of solar panels as an acceptable material. This facility is located at Block 1607, Lot 13.01, 1950 Rutgers University Boulevard in the Township of Lakewood.
